

Dear Professor von Hippel, Mr. Ahearn, and Mr. Garwin:

Thank you for your letter of May 31<sup>st</sup>, which arrived just as MIT began Commencement week.

I share your concern that a complete investigation of Professor Postol's allegations be allowed to proceed. I can assure you that MIT has consistently pursued, and continues to seek, an investigation of these allegations, including review of both the relevant classified and unclassified record.

On the subject of the Department of Defense Inspector General materials, MIT has been advised by a representative of the Inspector General that a Freedom of Information Act request is the appropriate way for Professor Postol to obtain the materials considered in the Inspector General's process. There is no reason why Professor Postol cannot obtain these materials in this manner, or why MIT should disregard the position of the Inspector General on that question under the Inspector General's process.
