This is a final response to your 14 July 2005 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for a copy of the CIA's Foreign Broadcast Information Service publication titled *Compilation of Usama Bin Ladin Statements 1994-January 2004*. GMP 20040209000243, February 9, 2004. We processed your request in accordance with the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552, as amended, and the CIA Information Act, 50 U.S.C. § 431. Our processing included a search for records as described in our 3 August 2005 acceptance letter existing through the date of that letter.

We located the report that you requested and determined that it must be denied in its entirety on the basis of FOIA exemptions (b)(3) and (b)(4). An explanation of exemptions is enclosed.

You have the right to appeal this decision by addressing your appeal to the Agency Release Panel within 45 days from the date of this letter, in my care. Should you choose to do this, please explain the basis of your appeal.
