Although that fact had 1 been properly classified, the President has determined that the United States' responsibility for 2 that operation can now be publicly acknowledged. 3 In its motion, the Department asked this Court to enter judgment in its favor on the basis 5 of the Office of Legal Counsel's Glomar response to the FOIA request in this case. Because that Glomar response was issued to protect the previously classified fact of whether or not the United 6 States contemplated and conducted the operation that resulted in Anwar al-Aulagi's death, the 7 Department respectfully withdraws its motion for summary judgment in this case. The 8 Department suggests that, within thirty days, it issue a modified response to Plaintiff's FOIA 9 request. After issuing that modified response, the Department proposes to confer with Plaintiff to 10 determine whether there are any disputes regarding the modified response that will require 11 resolution by the Court.
