1. The names and types of U.S. naval vessels involved in SIGINT collection [Redacted]

a. Banner, Belmont, Georgetown, Jamestown, Liberty, Muller (also seen as Mueller), Oxford, Pueblo, and Valdez. Among the types of ships represented here are AGTRs/Technical Research Ships (TRs) and AGERs/Environmental Research Ships. The fact that such ships were used for SIGINT collection is also releasable. 2. (U) The portion of the LG-Miscellaneous entry on "Message Routing Indicators/Delivery Distribution Indicators (DDIs)/CAGS/Canned Distribution" pertaining to SIGINT product report distributions will be amended to read:

(U) SIGINT product report "canned" distributions (for example OSCAR/NOVEMBER CHARLIE OR NSA/BRAVO JULIET) are releasable. This guidance applies to the "canned" SIGINT product distributions only and does not necessarily include the release of the actual recipients represented by the "canned" distribution or "write-in" recipients. If you are processing a list of recipients in a "canned" distribution, or "write-ins," please use the following guidance.

* (U) Use the NSA/CSS Classification Manual, particularly Annex C, Section A (Associations), regarding the provision of SIGINT to specific entities. For example, when processing SIGINT product reports that have been approved for segregable release, CIA may be released as a recipient because the fact that we provide SIGINT support to CIA is unclassified (NSA/CSS Classification Manual, Annex C, Section A, item A.27).

* (U) For Vietnam Conflict-related reports, use the Vietnam Conflict Product - Working Aid and the Vietnam Conflict Sites - Working Aid regarding the provision of SIGINT to specific entities during the conflict.
